Do you need to be CMMC compliant?

The CMMC framework is intended to protect Federal Contract and Controlled Unclassified Information (CUI). It includes governance, risk, policy, procedure and controls.
If you need to prepare your organization for CMMC compliance, now is the time.

Governance

Demonstrates that compliance is a priority to the business and executives have mechanisms in place to manage compliance at the business level.



Mainstream will examine all aspects of governance to assess the efficacy of the compliance mechanisms and recommend needed improvements.

Risk

Formally identifying threats to CUI and assessing their associated risk and prioritizing actions to address the risk.
